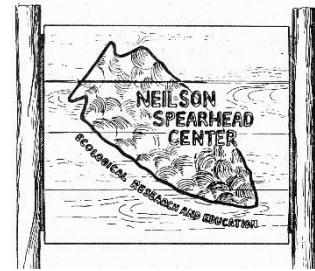


2018 SPEARHEAD YOUNG NATURALIST PROGRAM
