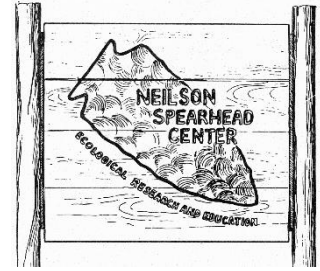


# 2025 SPEARHEAD YOUNG NATURALIST PROGRAM
